Payment Information

Payments: Monthly tuition payments must be set up with Smart Tuition, an outside billing service allowing parents flexibility in making payments.

There are three payment options available:

- Electronic Funds Transfer from your bank account
- Credit Card (Master Card, American Express, Discover or Visa)
- Payment by check

Missed Payments: A \$40 follow-up fee will be assessed by Smart Tuition for each missed payment. A late fee of \$35 will be charged by VCS for any late payment. Accounts remaining past due are reported to a credit reporting agency. Students may be subject to immediate dismissal from Vacaville Christian Schools if their tuition account becomes 30 days past due.

Withdrawal Policy: Your contract is for the entire school year. To withdraw a child from VCS (Grades K-12) after the student has been accepted, a withdrawal form must be completed by the parent and submitted to the Business Office.

Payment Option 1: 10 monthly payments: All payments will be processed via Smart Tuition. Billing cycle runs August 1st to May 1st.

Payment Option 2: 1 payment for annual tuition and fees, payable in full by August 1st via Smart Tuition.

Miscellaneous Fees

Each school maintains a list of current fees for miscellaneous activities such as: retreats, field trips, class projects, spirit clothes, clubs, athletics, band, social events, AP testing fees, lunch, snack bar, etc. These fees are billed as they occur.

Option 1 and Option 2 have same annual tuition pricing

Middle School Option 1: Tuition Includes textbooks. Students will be issued a report card for any courses they are enrolled in at VCS.

Tuition does not include all other academic records (must be kept by parent). Students are not issued a promotion diploma and do not receive any oversight by the home school coordinator.

Middle School Option 2: Tuition Includes textbooks, periodically scheduled meetings with the home school coordinator, report cards, maintenance of the student's CUM file, chapel attendance, open to school sponsored social events (extra fees may apply), sports eligibility, and PSAT/Iowa Testing (extra fee applies).

Tuition does not include: Retreats, field trips, class projects, spirit clothes, club fees, lunches, snack bar, and sports fees.

High School Option 1: Tuition Includes textbooks. Students will be issued a report card for any courses they are enrolled in at VCS.
