

# **Summer Academic Enrichment**

## **June 13th - August 5th**

Welcome to Kindergarten Readiness (KR) Summer Enrichment!

The purpose of the KR Summer Enrichment program is to help your child retain the knowledge he/she has acquired during the school year. Our program is designed to reinforce basic skill areas with hands-on math, science, writing, phonics, reading readiness, as well as Bible stories and a strong emphasis on Christian character training.

The summer enrichment program is available for children who will be attending Kindergarten in the fall of 2022. VCS KR Summer Program gives priority registration first, to currently enrolled families and secondly, to newly enrolled Kindergarten students. After current and new enrollments have been considered, any available spots will be open to the public. **Children must turn five (5) years old, by September 1st, 2022 to enroll in the KR Summer Program.**

During our Summer Enrichment Program, students will review counting numbers 1-100, writing numbers 1-20, letters and sounds of A-Z, blend consonants and vowels, shapes, colors, location prepositions, reading one vowel words, and a variety of planned activities to promote learning and retention.

Throughout the week, students will participate in the following Center Rotation:

**Language & Literacy**– This center will provide a variety of literacy activities to enhance the student's ability to master letter and sound recognition, blending sounds and creating words, reading CVC words, refine writing skills, hand and eye coordination, American Sign Language and public speaking.

**Math Center**- Math Center will provide math activities that reinforce number recognition, quantity, adding and subtracting, missing numbers, patterns, shapes, counting, and puzzles.

**Art & Science Center**– Art & Science Center will include activities such as cause and effect, cooking, exploring our environment and God's creation, as well as learning about the 6 Science Process Skills which include: observing, communicating, classifying, inferring, measuring and predicting. Children will also have opportunity for hands –on, open-ended creative art experiences.

**Chapel Time**- Building Biblical Character: Chapel time will include Bible stories, memory verses, music and movement, and mini puppet shows to help children develop Christ-like character, learn about God, and how much He loves us.

Please feel free to talk to any KR teacher about your child's strengths, growth areas and what you can do at home to help your child achieve maximum growth this summer.





# Welcome to Kindergarten Readiness Summer Program 2022!

Whether you are a current VCS family or a new family joining our program for the first time, we are excited to celebrate summer with you! Our program is designed with fun in mind, while helping students to maintain and strengthen their social, verbal, and academic skills. You will see your child grow in confidence while having fun in a safe and nurturing environment. We have a few important reminders to ensure your child has everything they need while at Summer Camp. Thank you for your support in these matters. If you have any questions, please feel free to speak with your child's teacher.



## Sunscreen-Please help us to protect your child this summer by:

1. Applying sunscreen at home every morning.
2. Sending extra sunscreen to school. Please label the container with your child's first initial and last name. (Must be in the original container/box.)
3. Signing the General Consent Form, giving VCS staff permission to apply more sunscreen to your child during the day.

**NOTE:** Please make sure the sunscreen is PABA Free and at least SPF 50.

## Nap/Rest Time for All Day Students

Mat covers are a must for children who stay for nap time. You may purchase them in the EE Office for \$18.00.



## Shoes for Summer

To ensure your child's safety on the playground, we ask that you DO NOT send your child to school in sandals. Instead, please send them in a lightweight, closed-toe shoe that will allow your child's feet to breathe, so that they may enjoy their playground experience.



## Dress Code- Dress for Fun and Safety

Superhero characters such as Spider-Man, Power Rangers, Pokémon, etc. are NOT allowed on apparel worn to school, backpacks, lunch boxes, shoes, and under- garments. Children are often stimulated by what they see and it can result in rough play. To ensure a safe play environment, we choose to refrain from images on clothing and other items that may encourage rough play.

Students may not wear necklaces or dangle earrings, as it is a safety hazard.

## Snack Time- Bringing and Providing Snacks

Kindergarten Readiness Summer Program will provide a snack in the afternoon for each child.

**Parents are asked to provide a morning snack for their child. Please bring an 8oz REFILLABLE water bottle for your child to have in the classroom.**

## Lunch

Students eat lunch at 11:30 A.M. Parents have the choice of packing a cold lunch or ordering a hot lunch from our school kitchen. Non-VCS students will need to buy a lunch card for purchasing hot lunch. Cards will be available for purchase the first day of our summer program. Please use a thermos or cooling packs to keep foods hot or cold when sending a lunch from home.

Lunches brought from home cannot be refrigerated or heated up at school. Lunches should be ready to serve (i.e. all food cut in bite size pieces, peeled, utensils included, etc.).

**Class Dojo:** You will be given Class Dojo access to receive reminders, pictures, and messages from the VCEE staff.

# General Information

**MEDICATIONS:** A medication form is required to administer any medication. This form and the medication must be taken to the classroom and given to the teacher. All prescription medications must be accompanied with a doctor's note. Any over the counter medications must be in the original container and can only be administered according to packaging directions

**ADMISSIONS AND ENROLLMENT:** Starting Monday, April 11, 2022, priority registration is given to current VCS families first, followed by newly enrolled families starting on Wednesday, April 27, 2022. VCS Preschool and Kindergarten Readiness Summer programs are open to the public for enrollment beginning Monday, May 9, 2022. Enrollment in the Summer Program at Vacaville Christian Schools has no bearing on enrollment for the academic year. There is no enrollment deadline; however, enrollment is based on a first-come, **first-served basis**. Programs have a maximum enrollment. Wait lists will be started once a program is full.

**CONDUCT AND ATTENDANCE:** Vacaville Christian Schools strives to make the campus a safe and secure place for your child to enjoy and learn during the summer months. With this priority in mind, the summer program policy must be clear to both parents and students. The signed and submitted registration form signifies that the parent and student understand and agree to abide by the following rules:

- The dress code is informal and students are expected to dress according to the Vacaville Christian Early Education Dress Code guidelines. Please see Parent Handbook for details at [www.GO-VCS.com](http://www.GO-VCS.com), under Parent Tab.
- Students must show respect and consideration towards teachers and other students. Please see Parent Handbook for more detailed information in regard to Conduct and Discipline Policies.
- Students are highly encouraged to arrive on time for academic enrichment.

**MATTHEW 18 PRINCIPLE:** If any conflict or disagreement arises with a staff member, we expect the parent to communicate any/all grievances honestly and directly with those concerned and then with the school administration, if needed.

**FEES:** Each student is required to pay a \$50 non-refundable enrollment fee. In addition, there is a \$15.00 fee for any scheduling change made after **May 31, 2022**. Written notification for all cancellations or changes is required. A \$30 fee will be charged on all returned checks.

# **PAYMENTS/FINANCIAL POLICIES: NEW VCS Families**

1. Monthly payments must be paid in full by the dates indicated on the registration form.
2. Full-time and Morning-Only programs cannot be interchanged in a given month. Notice must be given to the Early Education Office 30 days prior if there is a need to change a schedule or withdraw from the program.
3. Late fees are assessed for monthly payments not received by the due date in the amount of \$75. If payment is not received by June 1st, (1st payment) and July 1st (2nd payment) your child may not attend Summer Camp until payment is made, and they will be at risk of losing their spot in the program. Payment not made by the 15th of each month will result in the child being dropped from summer enrollment.
4. Late fees will be assessed for children who remain on campus after 6:00 P.M. in the amount of \$15 from 6:01-6:15 P.M. and an additional \$15 for every 15 minute portion thereafter. After two (2) occurrences this fee will be doubled to \$30 for every fifteen (15) minutes a child is left after 6:00 P.M. Students in Morning Only programs should be picked up once the class/program ends at noon. Thereafter, students will be charged an hourly rate of \$8.15 per hour billed in fifteen (15) minute increments.
5. Tuition will not be prorated due to absence for any reason.  
Spots cannot be held without full tuition payment.
