- Capital Outlay Committee

Motion, Joe "not to exceed \$589,743.00 taken from VCS cash reserves, for all phase 1 capital improvements to include asphalt, roof, refurbish playground, HVAC, Classroom doors, Restroom floors (gym restrooms),& campus cameras. This will include the HOS and Operations to return to the low and medium roofing vendors to review bids. Second Seth MSC U

During this board meeting, Joe motioned to revoke the above vote of not to exceed \$589,743, 2nd Seth MSC U

Joe motioned to approve the roofing project with Roof Solutions in the amount of \$267,700, 2nd Seth MSC U

The board will again review and vote upon the purchase and contracting for the remaining Tier 1 capital improvements; asphalt, refurbish playground, HVAC, classroom doors, restroom floors (gym restrooms), & campus cameras.
