ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

VCCHS offers a college-preparatory program designed to meet or exceed California A–G requirements for UC/CSU admission. Courses in Bible, Visual & Performing Arts, and Practical Arts have received UC A–G approval. Teachers provide regular academic support and tutoring throughout the week.

Students use Schoology (learning management system) and PowerSchool for real-time access to coursework, assignments, grades, and attendance, with one-to-one device integration throughout the high school.

VCCHS provides comprehensive college and career guidance throughout the high school experience. The College & Career Resource Center supports students through individualized college and career counseling, visits from college representatives, College Application Boot Camps, and grade-level college-preparatory workshops. Students also participate in PSAT testing beginning in 8th grade.

VCCHS maintains a single cumulative, weighted GPA on a 4.0 scale; the grading scale and Honors/AP weighting are detailed on the student transcript. Students are ranked by cumulative GPA.

OUR CAMPUS & FACULTY

VCCHS sits on a 26-acre campus in Vacaville, CA, with well-equipped classrooms, three science labs, a computer lab, media/technology facilities, a band rehearsal room with three practice studios, and a full hot-lunch kitchen. Athletic facilities include football/soccer and baseball/softball fields, two full-size basketball courts, a weight room, and locker rooms. Faculty are dedicated Christian educators engaged in ongoing professional development; AP teachers receive specialized AP Institute training.
